

## Chipping Sodbury School The PTA Committee

The Headteacher, Mr Lidstone, is President of the PTA and Mrs Jenny Clark is Vice-President. The PTA is a Registered Charity and is run in accordance with a Constitution which has been agreed by the Charity Commissioners.
