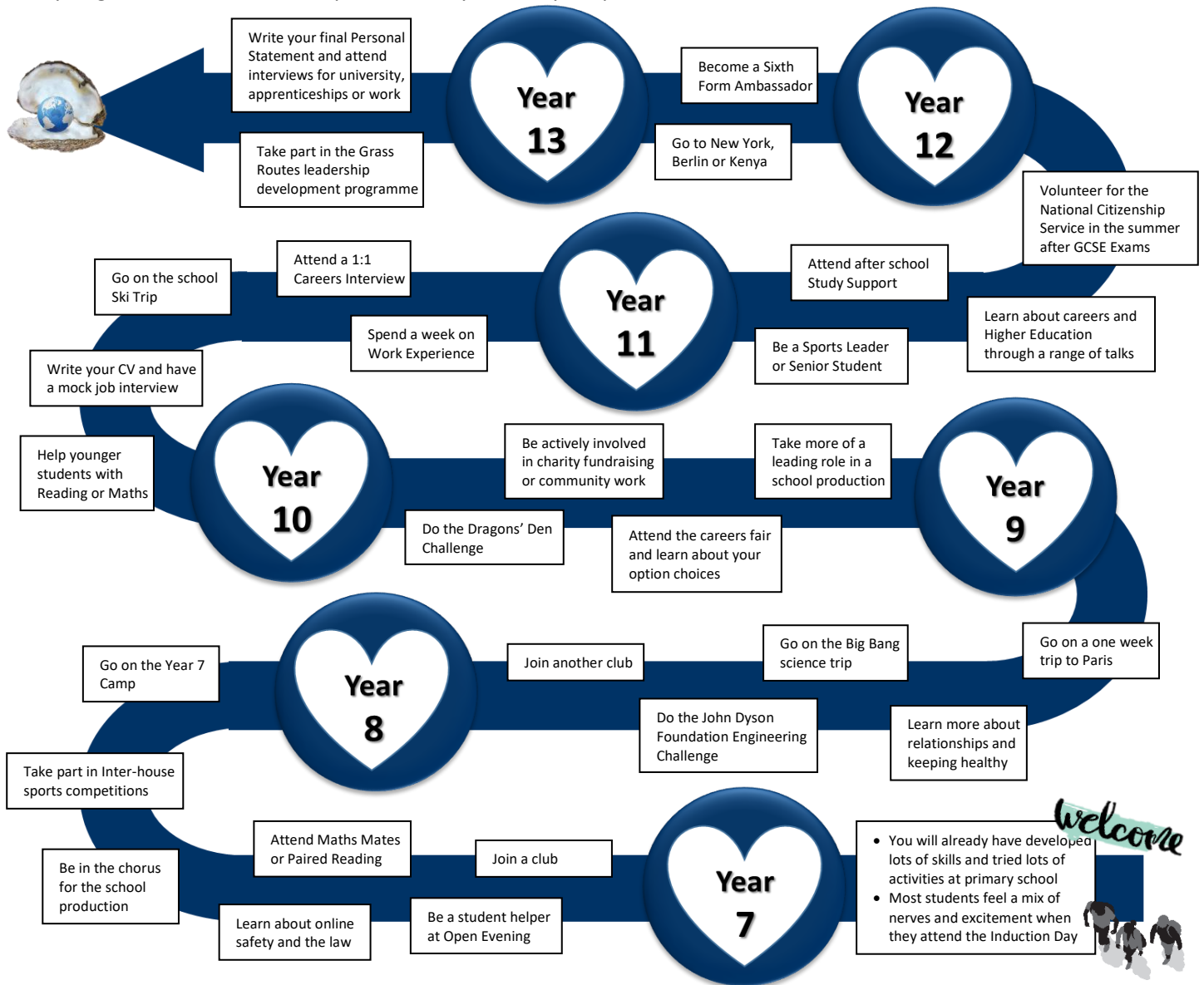




# Personal Development
