Dear Parent/Carer

A very warm welcome to the Chipping Sodbury School community. Your child will no doubt be nervous and excited about this transition from primary school and have lots of questions.

We will be communicating with you via email and/or text message over the coming weeks. During this term, and in the lead up to the induction programme, Mr White will be visiting and meeting each student joining us at their primary school and working with our primary colleagues to ensure a smooth transition. Mr White is the Pastoral Progress Lead for Year 6 and Year 7 and will oversee the transition and first year of your child's academic time with us.

Following each primary school visit, we will also be in contact with Year 6 teachers to discuss each child ahead of September. Getting to know your child is very important to us and building a strong, positive relationship with parents/carers will support your child enormously through their secondary school career.

Our induction day is planned for **Thursday 3rd July 2025** with a tutor parents' meeting for you to attend at the end of that day. Students are invited to join us during the day to meet their tutor and Head of House. Alongside having some orientation, they will experience some secondary school subjects and lessons. In the evening, you are welcome to attend a meeting with the tutor and to meet key members of staff. We are working to ensure we can prepare your child in the best way possible and to recreate much of the secondary school experience to support a smooth transition to both reassure and build confidence.

Key induction information relating to uniform, safeguarding, behaviour policy, canteen arrangements, transport, music lessons, suggested reading etc will be distributed to each child on the induction day. 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We will be keeping in regular contact with you and inviting you to complete electronic documents which will tell us more about each child and you as a family. Thank you in advance for submitting this information as it allows for a smooth transition into school for your child.

In the meantime, we don't want anyone to miss out so please can we ask you complete the following:

- Accept your child's place via the local authority online system, if you have not already done so
- If you applied late, please contact the Local Authority via telephone
- If you no longer require a place for your child, because you are moving outside of the area, please inform the Local Authority so that the place can be offered to another family
