Dear Parent/Guardian,

Starting secondary school is a significant milestone in your child's life, which can be both exciting and daunting for you and your child. Your child is taking a big step and starting a new chapter of their life marking a passage into adolescence.

Most children and young people thrive with the support of family, friends, and other important adults in their lives. However, the School Nursing Service is here for you and your family if, and when, you need a little more help – whether you need some information about the support available, some one-to-one help or some more specialist support.

Starting secondary school provides new opportunities for your child to access their school nurse independently should they wish to seek any advice or support about their own health and well-being. They can do this by visiting the school nurse at a Drop-in in their school, or by texting ChatHealth.

ChatHealth is a confidential text messaging service run by our School Nursing service for Children and young people aged 11-19. It enables young people to ask a school nurse confidentially about a range of issues. The ChatHealth number is **07312 263093**.
